For example this Thanksgiving weekend The FIS World Cup is being held at Killington. This is a pretty high-power event with world class women's skiing.

Information on how to view the events is as follows: For the first time in 25 years, World Cup alpine ski racing

returns to the Eastern US when the fastest female ski racers in the world converge on Killington Resort's Superstar trail to battle in the Slalom and Giant Slalom during the 2016 Audi FIS Ski World Cup on November 26 & 27. The public is invited to watch the action from the K-1 base area adjacent to the finish line of the races, where there is standing room for up to 8,000 spectators per day, plus a festival expo village featuring over 40 vendors and sponsors offering everything from local artisan food samples to demos of the latest ski industry technology.

On Saturday, O.A.R. will play a free concert in the K-1 base area immediately following the Giant Slalom racing. Racers from 27 countries will compete in Killington's first World Cup races, which will be broadcast in 60 countries worldwide. A full calendar of World Cup events during Thanksgiving Weekend at Killington including movie premiers and athlete autograph signings can be found at killington.com/worldcup.
